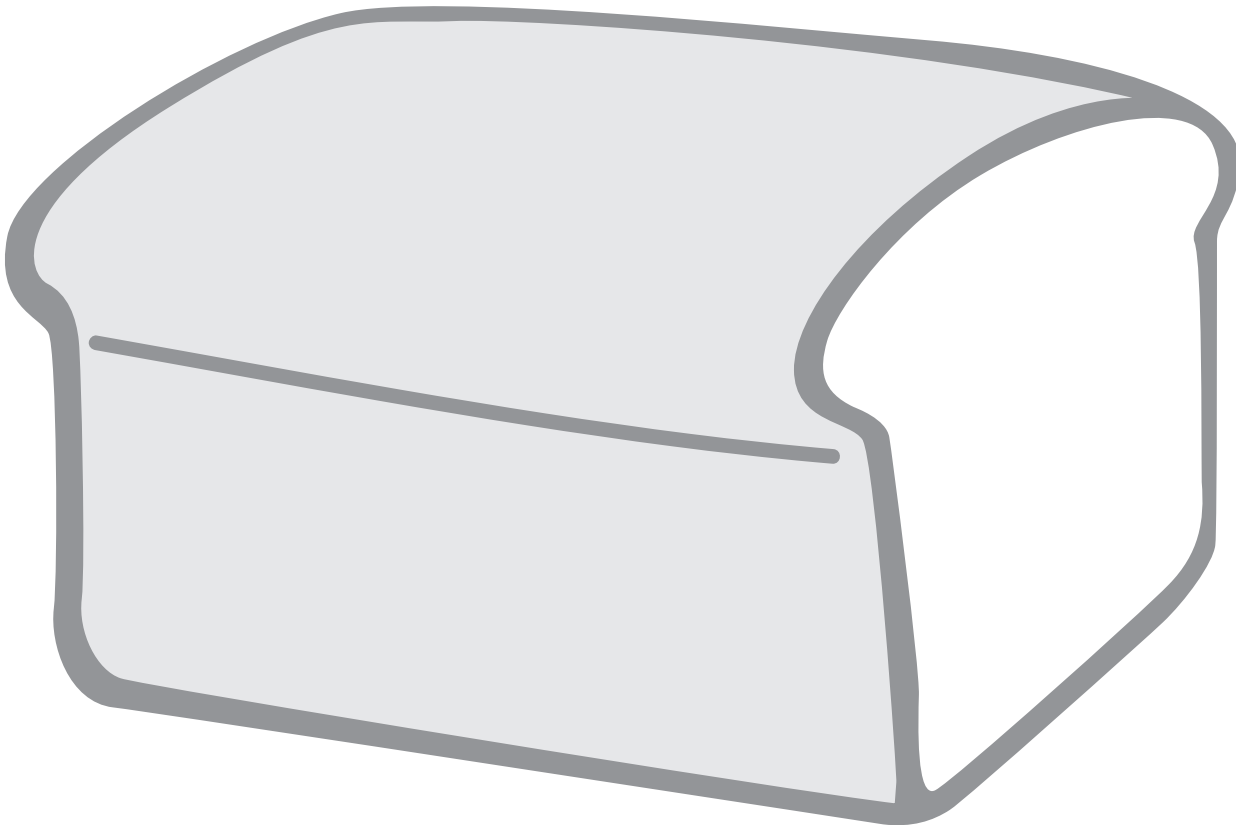
God gives us “daily bread” too. In the explanation of the Fourth Petition of the Lord’s Prayer, Martin Luther explains what the “daily bread” is that God provides for us.

What is meant by daily bread?

Daily bread includes everything that has to do with the support and needs of the body, such as **food, drink, clothing, shoes, house, home, land, animals, money, goods, a devout husband or wife, devout children, devout workers, devout and faithful rulers, good government, good weather, peace, health, self-control, good reputation, good friends, faithful neighbors, and the like.**
