

We are re-opening. There will be the opportunity to worship in person beginning June 28th. Council and elders have worked together to put protocols in place to allow us to worship together at Faith while adhering with AHS guidelines. Therefore both the visual appearance of the sanctuary and the practices we follow will look a little different. We have outlined some of these changes below:

- a) Upon entering please use the hand sanitizer available at the front doors.
- b) We will have a volunteer keeping track of who attends service so we may assist in contact tracing, should an outbreak occur. These records will only be kept for 2 weeks.
- c) This same individual will also track who takes communion for our records. This way you do not need to worry about filling out a communion card.
- d) Please maintain a 2-metre distance from anyone who is not in your cohort family (sorry, but no hugging or handshaking).
- e) There will be no bulletins, service folders, Bibles, or hymnals available—everything you need will be on the screen.
- f) Please allow ushers to direct you to an available pew—they have an idea how to best utilize seating to ensure fitting everyone in the sanctuary. Should we end up with more families than available seats, we will have seats in the parish hall and access to the service there too.
- g) Please always keep children in your pew with you .
- h) We will be having congregational singing, however, **if you choose to sing, we are asking that you please wear a mask.** We will have some masks available, but if you can bring your own that would be helpful. Otherwise humming, singing in your head, or just listening to the music is perfectly acceptable.

- i) The offering plate will not be passed during service, but an offering plate will be available at the back of the sanctuary; the debit machine will be available—please wipe after use with the provided wipes.
- j) Communion will be done pilgrim style with only one cohort family approaching the front of the sanctuary at a time. This will be done under the direction of the ushers. During communion you will not come into contact with other families or even with the pastors.
- k) Should you need to use the washrooms at Faith, we would request you use hand sanitizer prior to entering and after exiting.
- l) When service is finished we ask that you leave the sanctuary with the back pews emptying first and then moving forward. Please head directly outside and go in God's peace!
